The First Unitarian Society of Chicago has been making a difference in our community for decades.

Our church does not proselytize but rather is committed to social justice issues and seeks to help our less fortunate neighbors. Last year we donated over \$10,000 to projects locally and globally. Members spent hundreds of hours in our area tutoring, couching, working at food banks and raising funds and awareness for local school programs. We provide rental space to the Chicago Children's Choir, the Little Peoples' Learning Center and the Hyde Park School of Dance. We also provide free space to a number of nonprofit organizations for their meetings. Groups we have supported include:

We will be holding our annual fund-raising auction on Saturday, April 7, 2018. For the third year, 10% of the auction proceeds will go to an organization helping those who need help the most. This year's recipient will be the **Hyde Park & Kenwood Hunger Programs**. Founded in 1981, HPK Hunger Programs consists of two programs providing hot meals and other food to people who need it. The **Open Kitchen**, or Soup Kitchen, provides a hot noontime meal to about 200 people five days a week at Kenwood United Church of Christ at 46th & Greenwood. The **Food Pantry** provides groceries at Hyde Park Union Church each Saturday, 10–1. Financial contributions allow the Food Pantry to augment the supplies it receives from the Greater Chicago Food Depository each week.
